






Branded House



The branding is focused on the subset brands. Subset brands benefit from a strategic or operational alliance, but may serve customers in different ways, without an obvious connection for the consumer.




































Hybrid

- 9. Iconography



Branded house


- One central design system feeding all the sub-brands
- Design system is "strict" and changes are controlled
- Overriding styles on components is discouraged





House of brands


- One central design system feeding all the sub-brands with as much elements as possible
- Every sub-brand has its own design system





Hybrid

- Mix of branded house and house of brands
- One or several design systems will feed the organization
























Why Stitch was created


- 30+ style sheets
