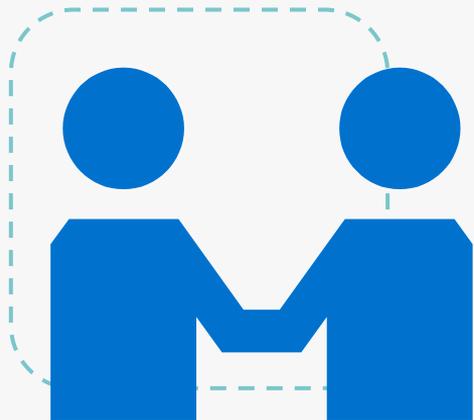

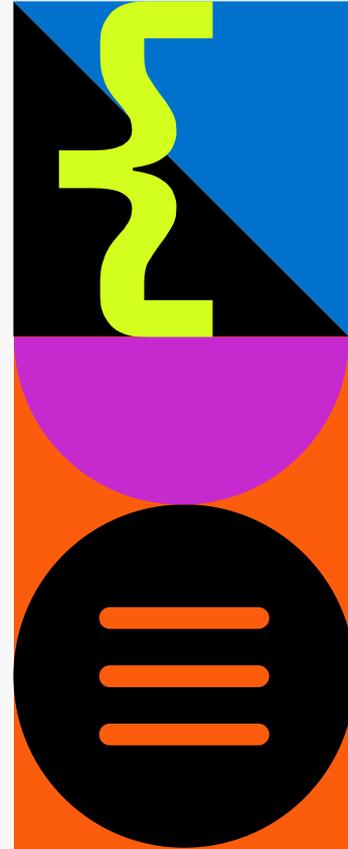

# Contribution types



## Code

- Core product/engines
- Extensions/plug-ins
- Example code
- Triage/label GitHub issues



## Documentation

- “Edit on GitHub” button
- Minor fixes to major rewrites



## Ideas & feedback

- Feedback on new features
- Feature/content requests



## Expertise

- Answer forum/Stack Overflow questions
- Create a blog, video, etc.
- Give a talk



## Community

- Host or organize a meet-up
- Speak at a meet-up
- Build with other members
