UNITED NATIONS, N.Y., May 7 — Smallpox, one of the deadliest and oldest viral diseases of humans, has been eradicated from the earth, World Health Organization officials said today in a news conference broadcast here from Geneva.

The death of smallpox, which had been reported in stages over the last two years, marks the first time in history that the natural transmission of a disease has been completely stopped. Public health leaders have hailed the accomplishment as a milestone in medicine.

The official declaration of the eradication of smallpox will be made in ceremonies tomorrow at the World Health Assembly, now being held in Geneva.

The health organization began the intensified smallpox eradication program in 1967. In that year, smallpox was reported in 42 countries and killed two million people. It also scarred and blinded another eight million people.

An immediate effect of the eradication program has been to make smallpox vaccinations needless, thereby eliminating the risks from that centuries-old procedure. Also, no person will need to have evidence of a smallpox vaccination for travel to any country at any time.



Literate and illiterate world population The share of adults aged 15 and older who can both read and write.







Child deaths in the first year of life, World Number of newborns who died before reaching the age of one. Shown by the time period in which they died.


