Remote versus Co-located Work

There's a big push at the moment to remote work, and I see it as a good thing, but I think there are several patterns of distribution for teams each of which has different trade-offs and effective techniques suitable for them. While it's impossible to determine conclusive evidence, my sense is that teams are doing better working in a co-located manner. But you can still be productive even using a distributed working model, because it gives you access to a wider talent pool.

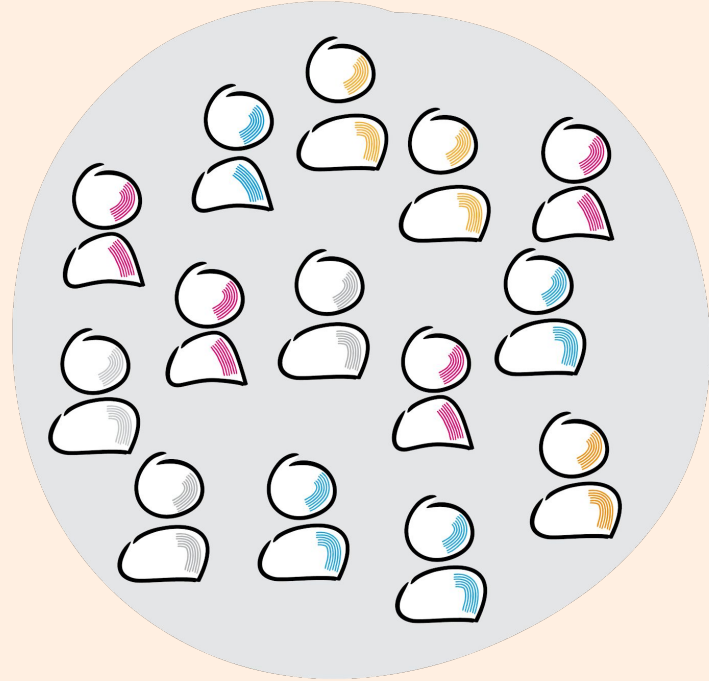

Accelerated timeline to “go-remote”

STAGE 1

- Prioritize ‘must-have’ infrastructure such as VPN and communications tools such as headsets, video cameras and conferencing software.
- Ensure access to critical services is available remotely, including source control, build pipelines, and dev/test/prod environments.
- If your country hasn’t already moved into lock down, do a ‘remote-trial’ day as soon as possible to discover any limitations or challenges, then aggressively pursue fixes or workarounds.
- For team members able to work remotely, immediately extend their remote trial into full remote working.
- Begin ‘social distancing’ measures for any remaining co-located team members. Evaluate health vulnerability of all team members.
- Set expectations with stakeholders. This is not a normal transition to remote working. It is being done in a hurry, in a climate of worry and stress. Teams will adjust, but it will be rocky to begin with.
- Follow advice from local authorities on any further measures that are appropriate.

Dear all,

From Monday, March 16 until further notice, the FT Group organisation will move to Working From Home (WFH) at scale. We continue to test our systems in this regard, but are confident that most functions are able to work remotely to a satisfactory degree. We will continue preparations for this scenario in the days ahead and monitor the effects in real time. Your assistance in making this happen will be greatly appreciated: the approach will be reviewed on a weekly basis.

There will be some exceptions to this approach and additional, regional nuances: please look to your board directors and team leaders for specific guidance.

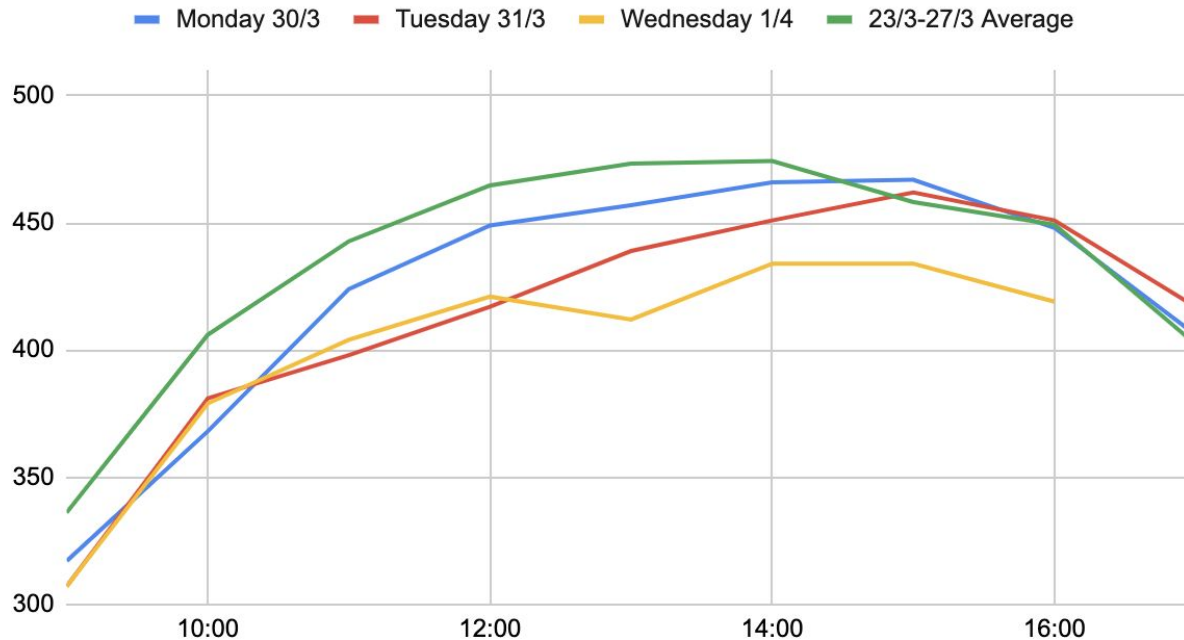

The Proposal Process

The proposal process is a standardised, simple and structured Request for Comments process in the form of a technology proposal document. A person or group of people will author a technology proposal describing a need, a proposed solution, impacts, benefits, costs and alternative options considered. The process for drafting, seeking feedback, endorsement and implementation of technology proposals is outlined below.

When should a technology proposal be raised?

It is important that proposals are submitted for appropriate changes, to ensure we only expend effort providing feedback and reviewing appropriately. The following types of change characterise what typically might warrant submission for feedback and review by the Tech Governance Group.

Changes with Broad Impact Across Technology.

- This typically means when more than one technology group will have to invest significant time or money, or make major changes to their processes or technologies used as a result of the proposal.

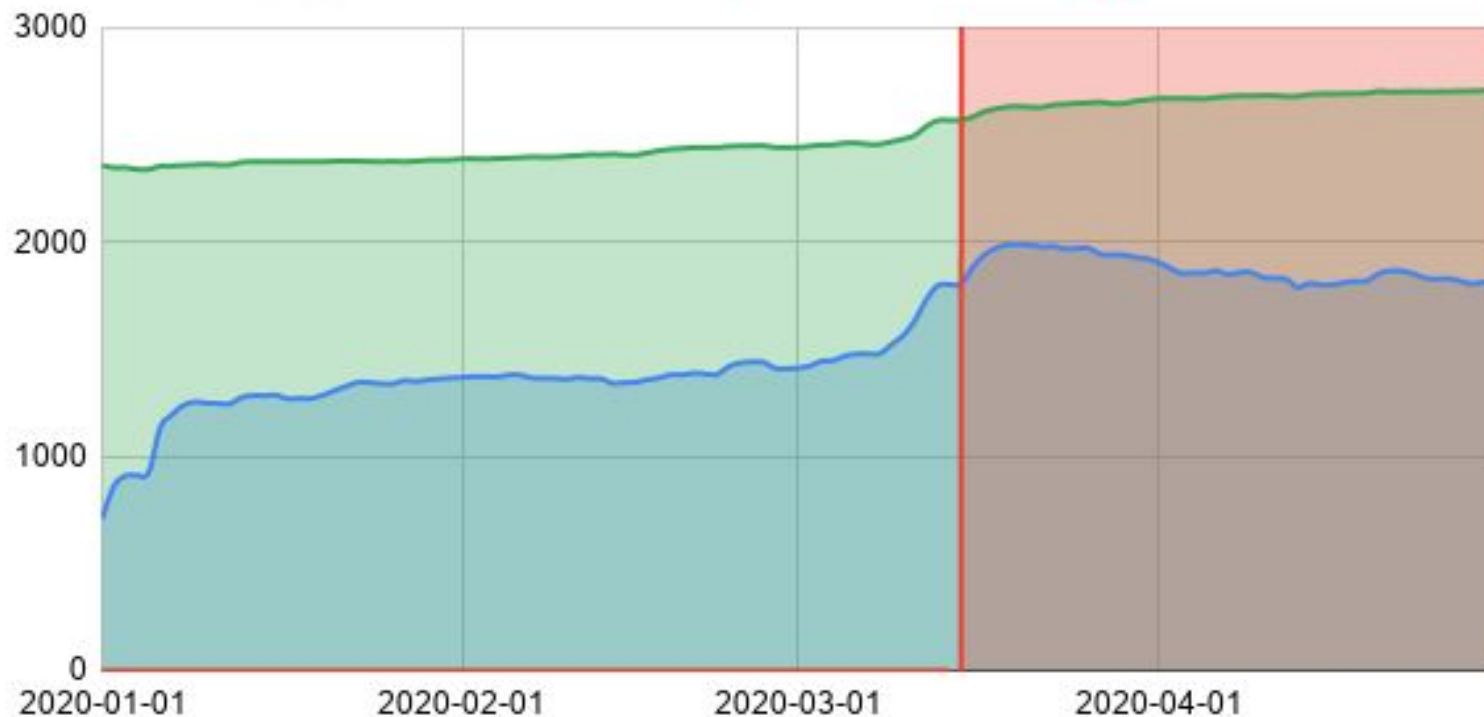

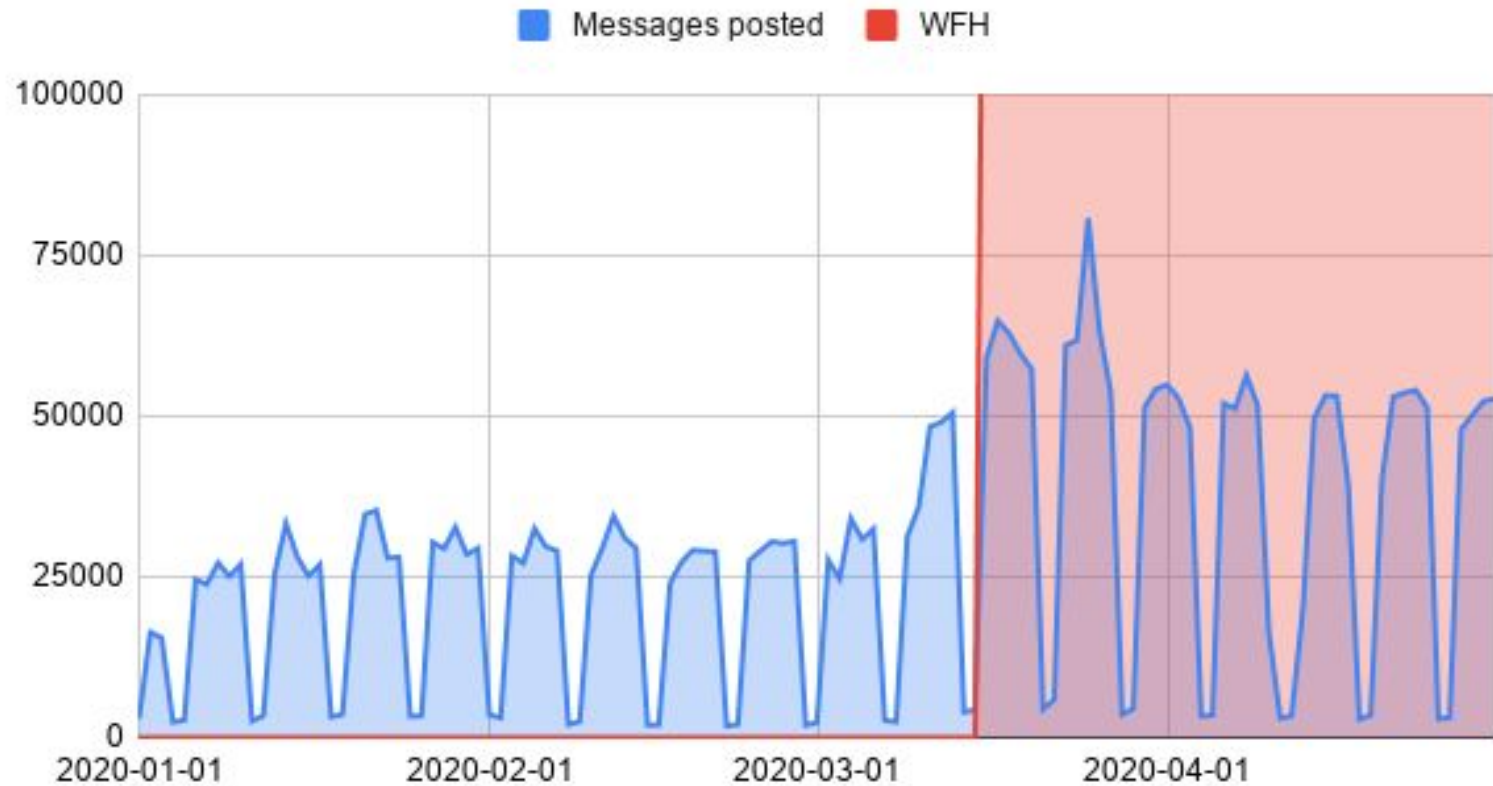

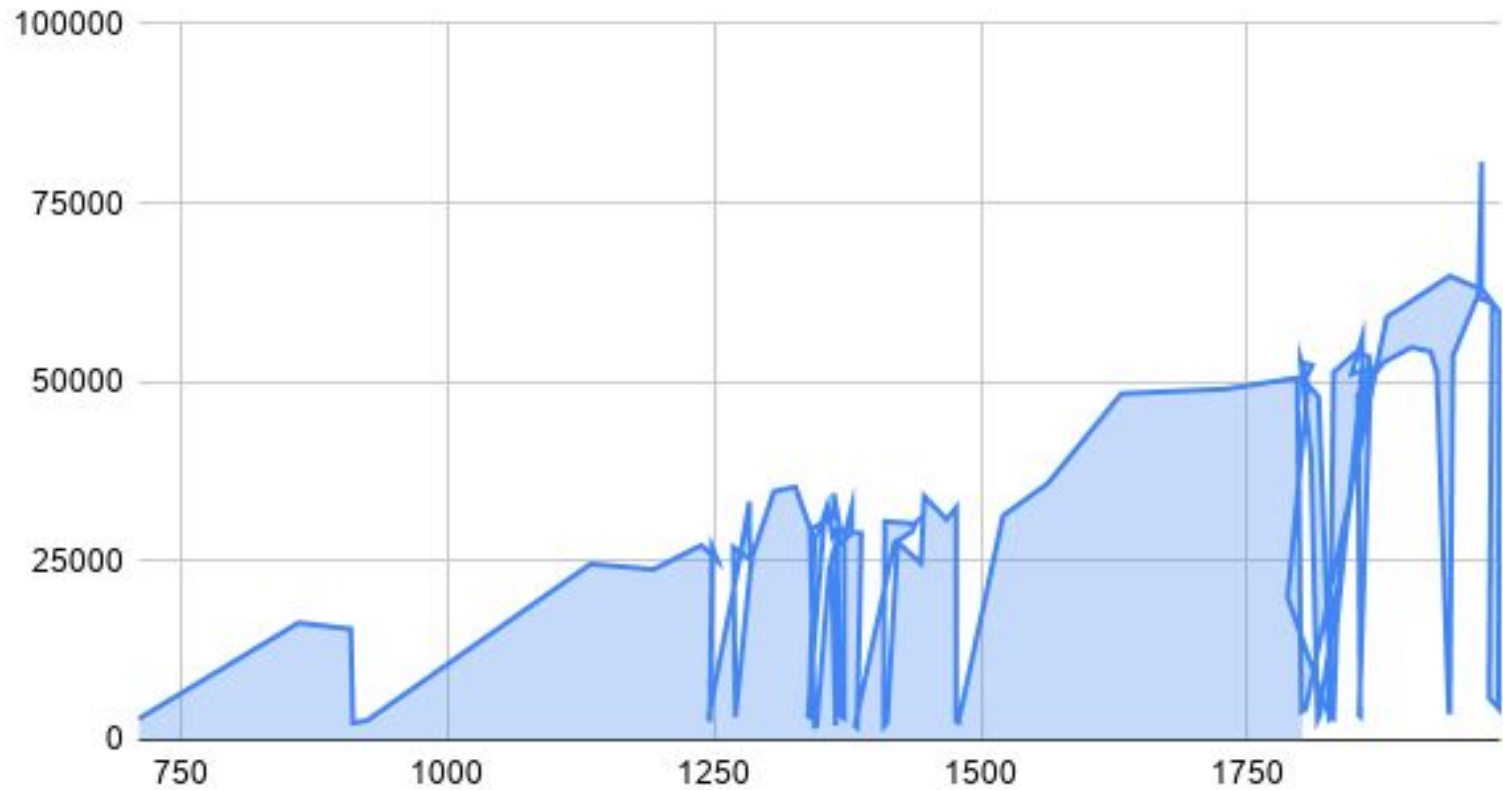

Dual Team Channels

What: Create a pair of public and private channels for Product/Service teams.

Why: The public team channel helps to reinforce team-based ownership over individual ownership – as it provides a space for people to talk to the team – while the private channel provides a space for the team to talk internally.

Community Channels

What: Create a public channel for the communities of people within your organisation.

Why: It provides a space for the community to talk within itself, and for people to talk to the group. It also allows any interested party to follow the lifecycle of a community from Forming to Adjourning.

Within Equal Experts, community channels are formed around various areas, including client; business unit (eg. Lisbon); office; specific technologies or tools; and specific areas of practice (eg.UX).

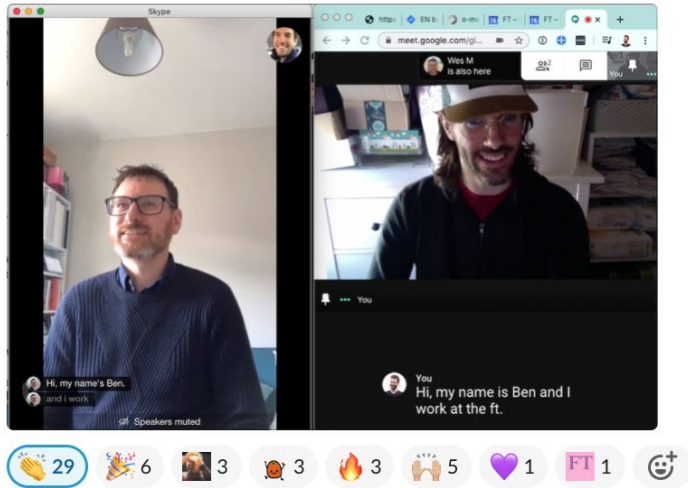



