

"All teams will henceforth expose their data and functionality through service interfaces."

"Teams must communicate with each other through these interfaces."

"There will be no other form of interprocess communication allowed [...]the only communication allowed is via service interface calls over the network."

"It doesn't matter what technology they use. HTTP, Corba, Pubsub, custom protocols – doesn't matter."

"All service interfaces, without exception, must be designed from the ground up to be externalizable."

"Anyone who doesn't do this will be fired."

AMAZON LEARNED SOME THINGS

"pager escalation gets way harder, because a ticket might bounce through 20 service calls before the real owner is identified"

"every single one of your peer teams suddenly becomes a potential DOS attacker"

"monitoring and QA are the same thing..."

"...the only thing still functioning in the server is the little component that knows how to say 'I'm fine, roger roger, over and out' in a cheery droid voice"

"you won't be able to find any of them without a service-discovery mechanism [...] which is itself another service"
