14 to 30 days before sailing: Changes are less likely to be approved and may require more justification or supporting documentation.

Less than 14 days before departure: Carnival usually does not permit any name changes during this period unless it's a legal name change due to marriage, divorce, or a court order. Once online check-in is completed (typically 72 hours before the cruise), no name changes are allowed.

How Much Does a Name Change Cost?

Carnival Cruise name change fees vary depending on the nature of the change and how early you request it.

- Minor spelling corrections are often free.
- Name updates typically start at \$50 and can go higher depending on the change.
- Full passenger swaps may cost \$100 or more.
- If your booking includes airfare (especially restricted air), fees may be significantly higher or changes might not be allowed at all.

Fees can also vary if you booked through a travel agent or third-party site.

How to Change a Name on Your Carnival Cruise Booking?

You have three main options for making a name change on your Carnival reservation:

Online via Carnival's Website

Log in to your booking through the "Manage My Booking" section and look for the "Modify Guest Information" option. Simple spelling errors can often be corrected here.

Call Carnival Cruise Line

Contact Carnival directly at 1–800-CARNIVAL to request a name change. You'll need to provide your booking details and possibly submit documentation for certain changes.

Through Your Travel Agent

If you booked your cruise through a travel agency, the agency will need to process the name change for you. Additional fees may apply depending on the agency's policies.

Can You Transfer a Carnival Cruise to Another Person?

In many cases, yes. Carnival allows full passenger substitutions, but conditions apply:

 The original passenger may need to cancel, and the new passenger will have to rebook at the current fare.

- Not all fare types allow name transfers, especially heavily discounted or promotional rates.
- Additional charges may include a name change fee and any fare difference between the original and current rate.

It's best to inquire directly with Carnival or your travel agent to confirm whether your booking qualifies for a name transfer.

How to Avoid Name Change Fees

Here are a few ways to reduce or eliminate Carnival Cruise name change fees:

- Double-check all names at the time of booking to avoid typos.
- Avoid restricted fare types if flexibility is important to you.
- Make corrections as early as possible, preferably more than 30 days before departure.
- Provide legal documentation (like a marriage certificate or court order) if the change is due to a legal name update.
