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WCAG Web Content Accessibility Guidelines https://www.w3.org/TR/WCAG21/

Success Criterion 1.4.3 Contrast (Minimum)

- The visual presentation of text and images of text has a contrast ratio of at least 4.5:1, except for the following: (Level AA)
 - Large Text: Large-scale text and images of large-scale text have a contrast ratio of 3:1
 - Incidental: Text or images of text that are part of an inactive user interface component, that are pure decoration, that are not visible to anyone, or that are part of a picture that contains significant other visual content, have no contrast requirement.
 - Logotypes: Text that is part of a logo or brand name has no minimum contrast requirement.

How to Meet WCAG 2.0 Success Criterion (SC)

- Situation A: text is < 18 point (24 px) if not bold and < 14 point

Situation B: text is at least 18 point if not bold and at least 14 point if bold.

Success Criterion 1.4.6 Contrast (Enhanced)

 - ratio of at least 4.5:1
 - contrast requirement.
 - Logotypes: Text that is part of a logo or brand name has no contrast requirement.





Tips for Great Color Contrast

- Font weights, SIZES, and colors matter.
- Test your color palettes.
- Ratios that exceed the minimums of 4.5 to 1, 3 to 1, or 7 to 1.

Avoid stark contrasts with text which can result in blurred text.
