Effective Design Workflow

- Share wireframes and mock-ups as soon as possible, keeping nomenclature in mind
- Keep a list of assets that will be needed for each component
- Predict potential technical issues with the design



Homepage Wireframing

- Start by sketching out ideas
- Move to drafting program
- Get design feedback from team and client

- Less development time with reusable and flexible components
- Ability to show components and pages to the client
