ISMP IV Push Medication Guidelines







Guidelines

- Provide IV push medications in a ready to administer form
- Use only commercially available or pharmacy prepared prefilled syringes of IV solutions to flush and lock vascular access devices
- If available in a single dose vial buy in single dose vial
- Aseptic technique used when preparing and administering IV medication
 - Hand hygiene before and after administration
