I have encountered an issue when using the Media Library Edit module in combination with the Gin theme.

The Media Library Edit module adds an "Edit" button to the Media Library widget, allowing users to edit media entities directly from the node edit form. When the "Edit" button is clicked, a modal opens containing the media edit form. but, on the Gin theme, the modal does not display the save button, preventing users from saving their changes to the media entity.

I found that the Gin theme uses a custom template for the node edit form (node-edit-form.html.twig). This template excludes the 'actions' element from the form using the following line:

I was able to isolate the issue to a situation where it works if the `drupal.contextualLinks` is loaded (contextual module enabled and user has permission to use contextual links) and it fails if the library is not loaded. If that library is present, it also loads the `core/drupal.ajax` library before the `edit_form` library, which makes the ajax system process the action buttons before GIN changes the IDs. If the contextual links library is not present, the core ajax library is loaded after GIN makes these changes with the result that the ajax behaviours for the action buttons do not work.

Steps to reproduce

- Install Drupal with the default profile (`drush site-install`)
- Enable GIN and set it as the admin theme (`drush then gin && drush config-set system.theme admin gin -y`)
- Create a custom module, e.g. `gin_demo` with this content for the module file:

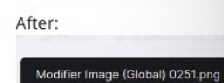

The sticky action buttons should not be used when a form appears in a modal. This works OK for first request that opens the modal but it fails for subsequent ajax requests that refresh the form within the modal. An example for this is core's media library, which appears OK when being opened but after switching the media type, the action buttons disappear.

When fixing this, make sure that this doesn't break other tools that do fancy things, e.g. admin_dialogs.

Proposed resolution

Use AjaxHelperTrait::isAjax in isModalOrOffCanvas to determine when the current request is an ajax call. In that case, the sticky action buttons should not be used.

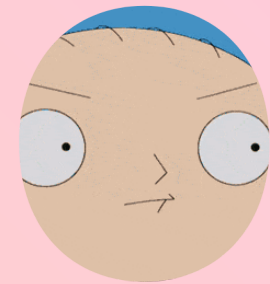
