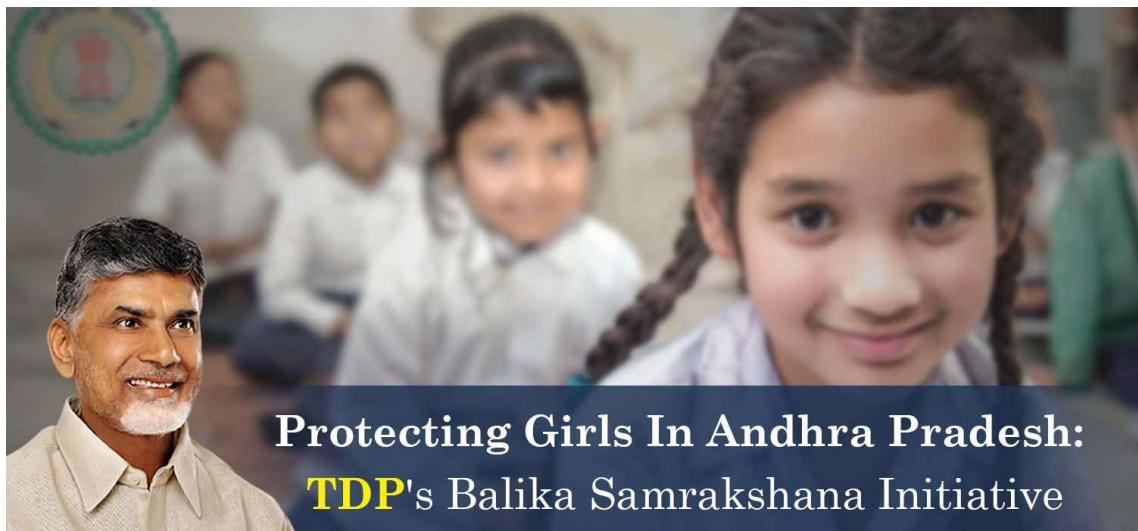


## Protecting Girls In Andhra Pradesh: TDP's Balika Samrakshana Initiative
