






2.5.1 Pointer Gestures Define simple pointer gestures





Pinch = complex





Simple gestures — one finger Tap

Double-tap

Long-press



Complex gestures

Swipe

Tap & drag (slider)

Tracing a path

Pinch zoom

One finger hold, second finger tap

Multi-finger tap or swipe

(e.g. swipe to scroll browser)




