
# LACK OF EXECUTIVE SUPPORT

Without strong leadership commitment, it can be hard to secure the necessary resources and organizational focus on BCMS




# RESISTANCE TO CHANGE

Employees may resist new processes or view BCMS implementation as additional workload, slowing adoption



# POOR UNDERSTANDING OF REQUIREMENTS

Limited knowledge or misinterpretation of ISO 22301 standards leads to incomplete or ineffective implementation




# INADEQUATE DOCUMENTATION AND RECORD KEEPING

Insufficient or disorganized documentation hinders compliance, audit readiness, and process consistency



# INTEGRATION DIFFICULTIES

Aligning BCMS with existing corporate processes and systems can be complex, requiring effort to achieve synergy



# RESOURCE CONSTRAINTS

Limited budget, personnel, and time often restrict thorough implementation & maintenance, especially in smaller organizations

# INCONSISTENT TESTING AND EXERCISES

Organizations may not adequately test or update their business continuity plans, reducing their effectiveness during real incidents



# INEFFECTIVE COMMUNICATION

Poor internal communication can cause confusion regarding roles and expectations in continuity plans



# MAINTAINING CERTIFICATION

Sustaining ISO 22301 certification through surveillance audits requires ongoing system maintenance and improvements, which can be challenging for organizations
