Smith will not collect his annual bonus, according to his agreement with Equifax. He will be on hand for the next 90





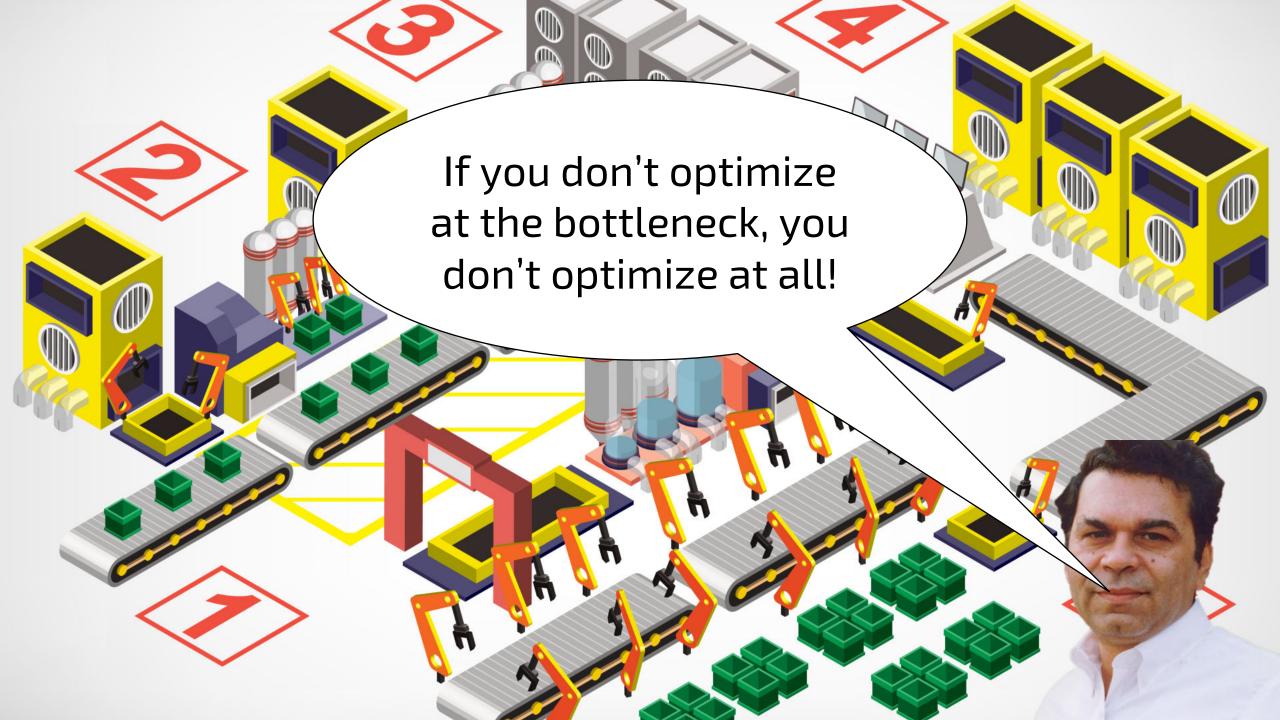
