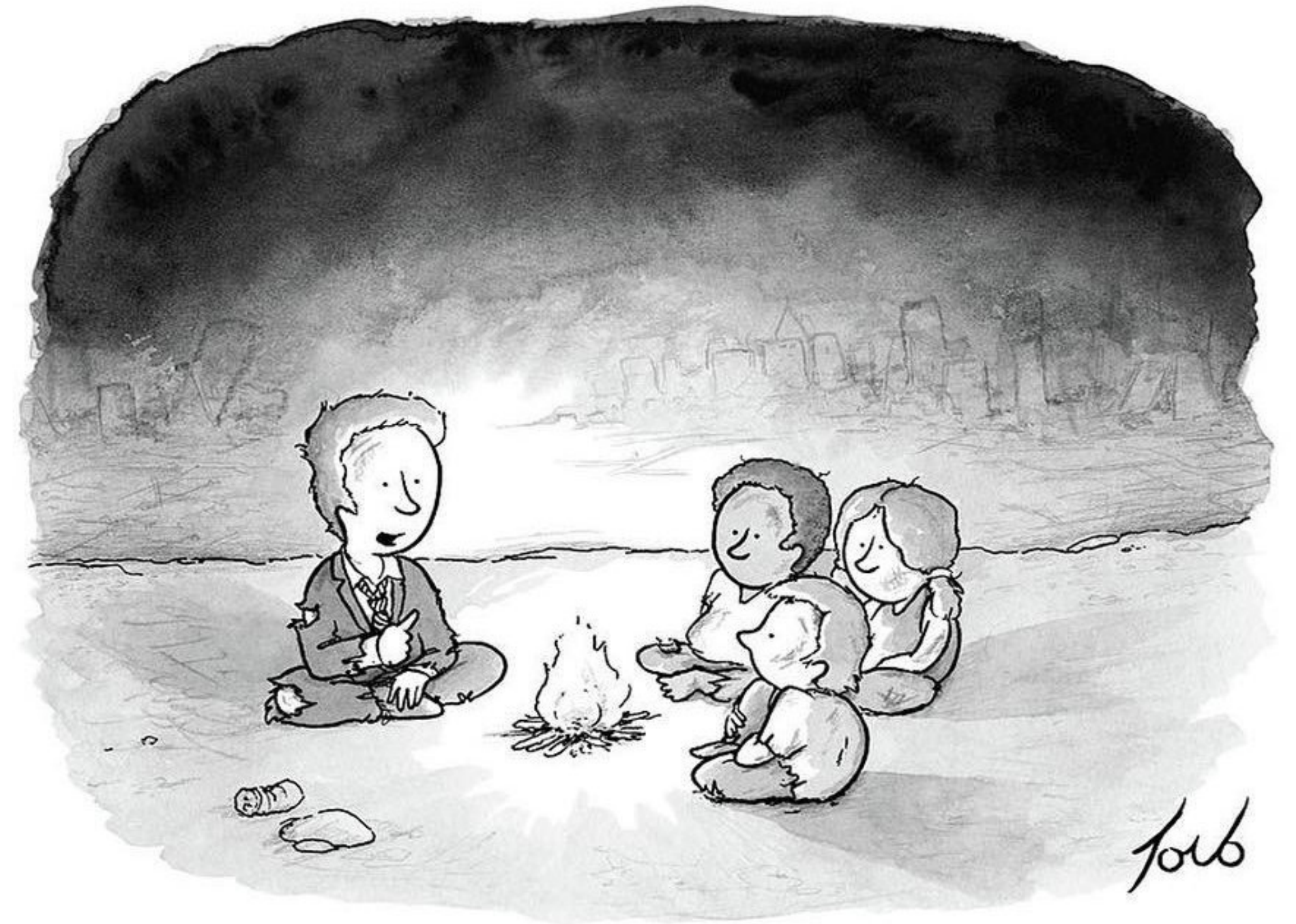

A life-centered design approach that acknowledges the complex interplay of social, economic, political, cultural, and environmental factors in order to create more just and equitable futures. Holistic design entails working in small, local and open groups to ensure that the work results are contextualised and accessible to all.
