### Notre capacité à lire dépend énormément du contexte dans lequel nous nous trouvons.




## Notre capacité à lire est aussi influencée par la manière dont nos yeux fonctionnent.





# Lisibilité & contenu web.



## D'abord, Open Dyslexia n'est pas vraiment une solution.



## L'information la plus importante doit être dans les deux premiers paragraphes.



### Utiliser des hiérarchies de titres

(pour permettre aux utilisateurs de rapidement scanner le contenu, quelque soit le matériel utilisé (visuel, screen readers, web rotors, etc.))



## Débuter les titres avec les mots porteur du sens.



## Grouper les petits contenus similaires avec un système visuel commun



## Mettre en valeur les éléments importants avec des systèmes de graisses et/ou de couleurs



## Évitez les contenus trop génériques, soyez spécifique (surtout pour les liens).



## Soyez sémantique et visuels.

(par exemple, une liste doit apparaître comme une liste...)



## Garder un layout constant peut motiver les utilisateurs à lire plus lorsqu'ils recherchent une information.



## Garder un layout constant est nécessaire pour aider les personnes dys\*, les troubles de l'attention et les personnes autistes.



Et enfin...







### Diminuez vos contenus.



## Et quand vous avez fini... Retirez encore la moitié!

## Symbols are becoming a design standard






In April 2016, Sketch re-introduced Symbols to save designers more time.
