we have something called *fixation*.





& contenu web.



D'abord, **Open Dyslexia**
n'est **pas vraiment** une solution.



L'information la **plus importante** doit être
dans les **deux premiers paragraphes**.



Utiliser des hiérarchies de titres

(pour permettre aux utilisateurs de rapidement scanner le contenu, quelque soit le matériel utilisé (visuel, screen readers, web rotors, etc.))



Débuter les titres avec
les mots porteur du sens.



Grouper les petits contenus similaires
avec un système visuel commun



Mettre en valeur les éléments importants
avec des systèmes de graisses et/ou de couleurs



Évitez les contenus trop génériques,
soyez spécifique (surtout pour les liens).



Soyez **sémantique** et **visuels**.

(par exemple, une liste doit apparaître comme une liste...)



Garder **un layout constant** peut
motiver les utilisateurs à lire plus
lorsqu'ils recherchent une information.



Garder un layout constant est nécessaire
pour aider les personnes dys*, les troubles de
l'attention et les personnes autistes.



Et enfin...





Diminuez vos contenus.



Et quand vous avez fini...
Retirez encore la moitié !

From troubled dreams, he found himself transformed in his bed into a horrible vermin. 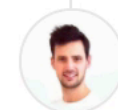
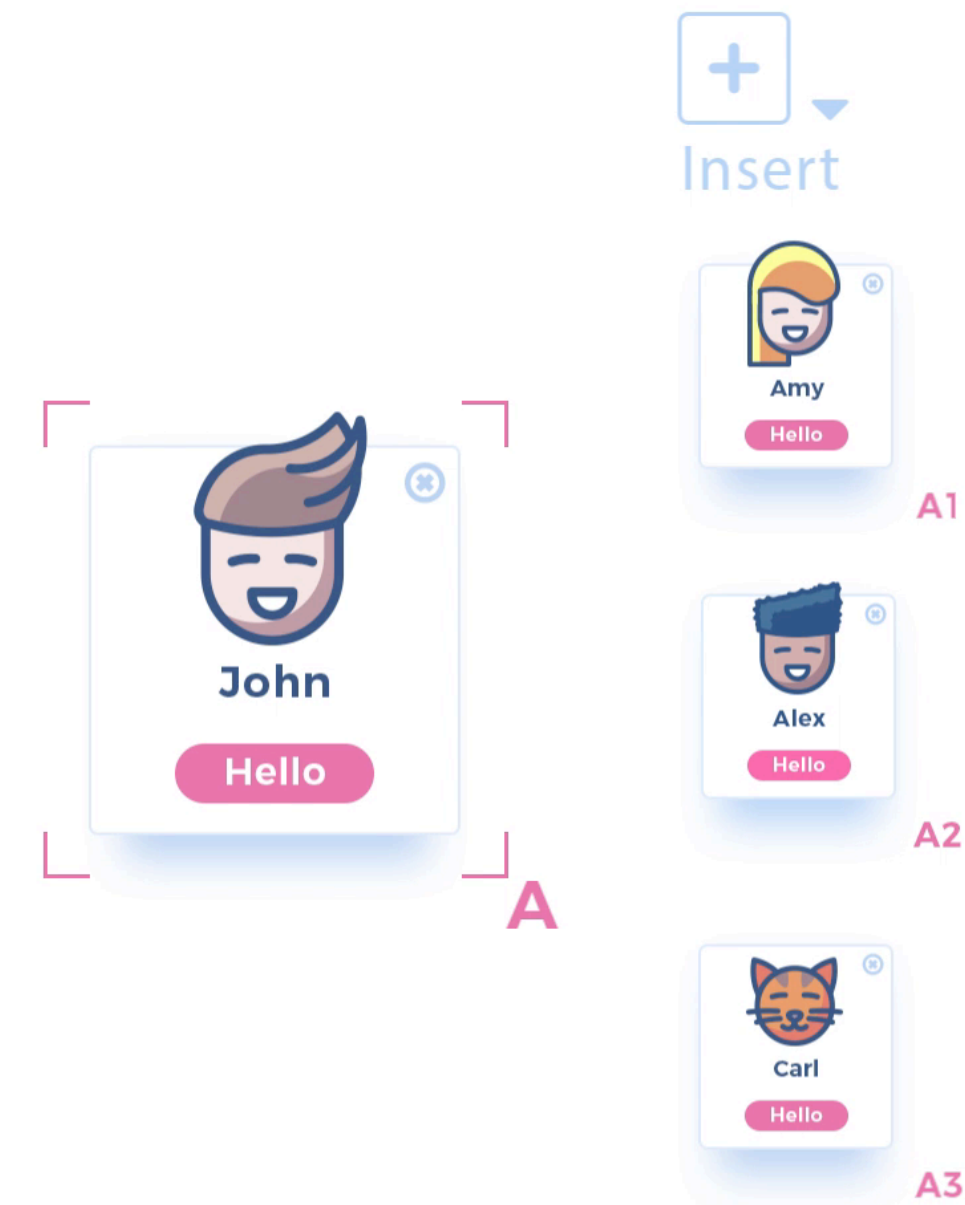
DESIGN COMPONENTS
