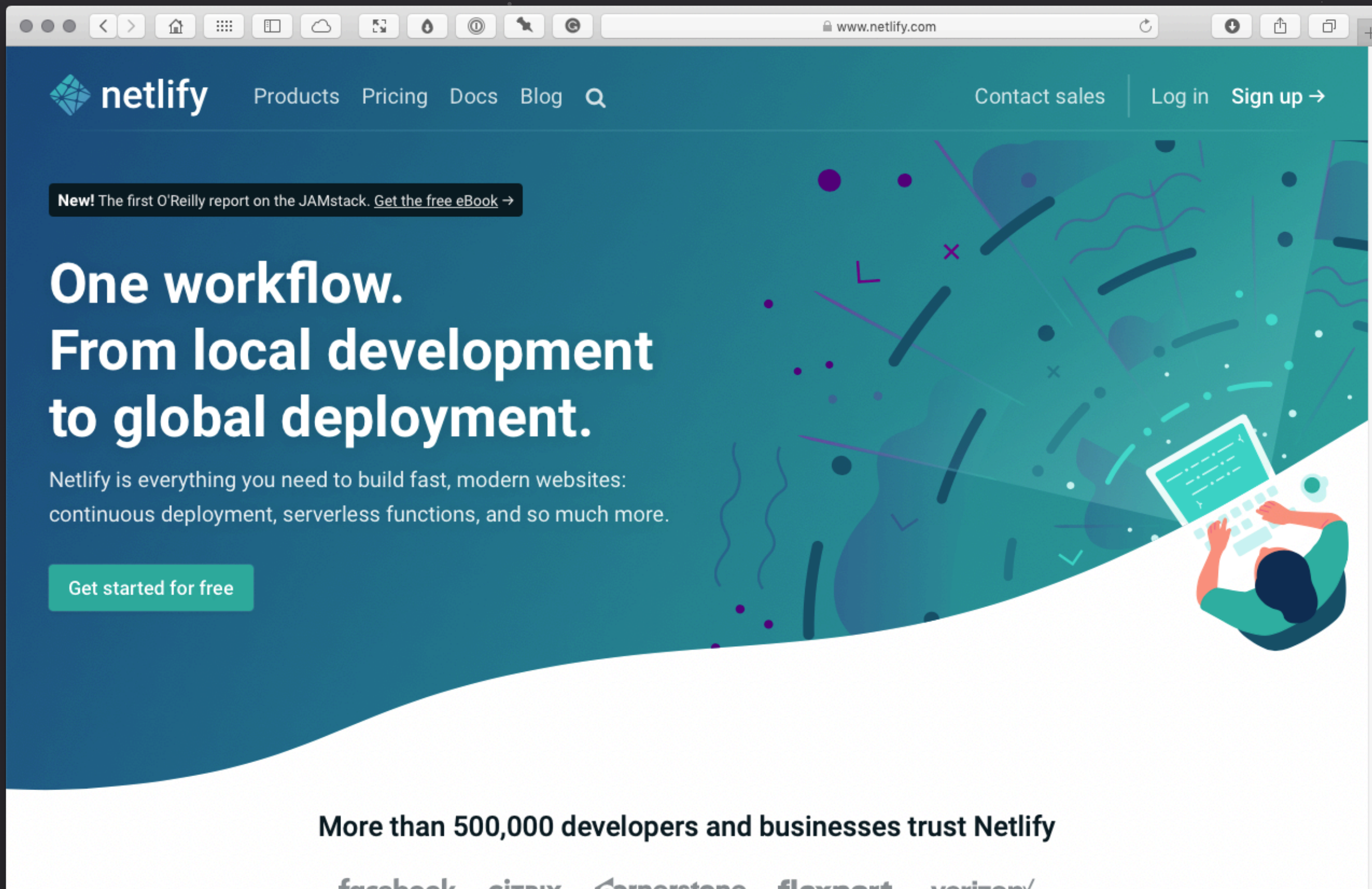

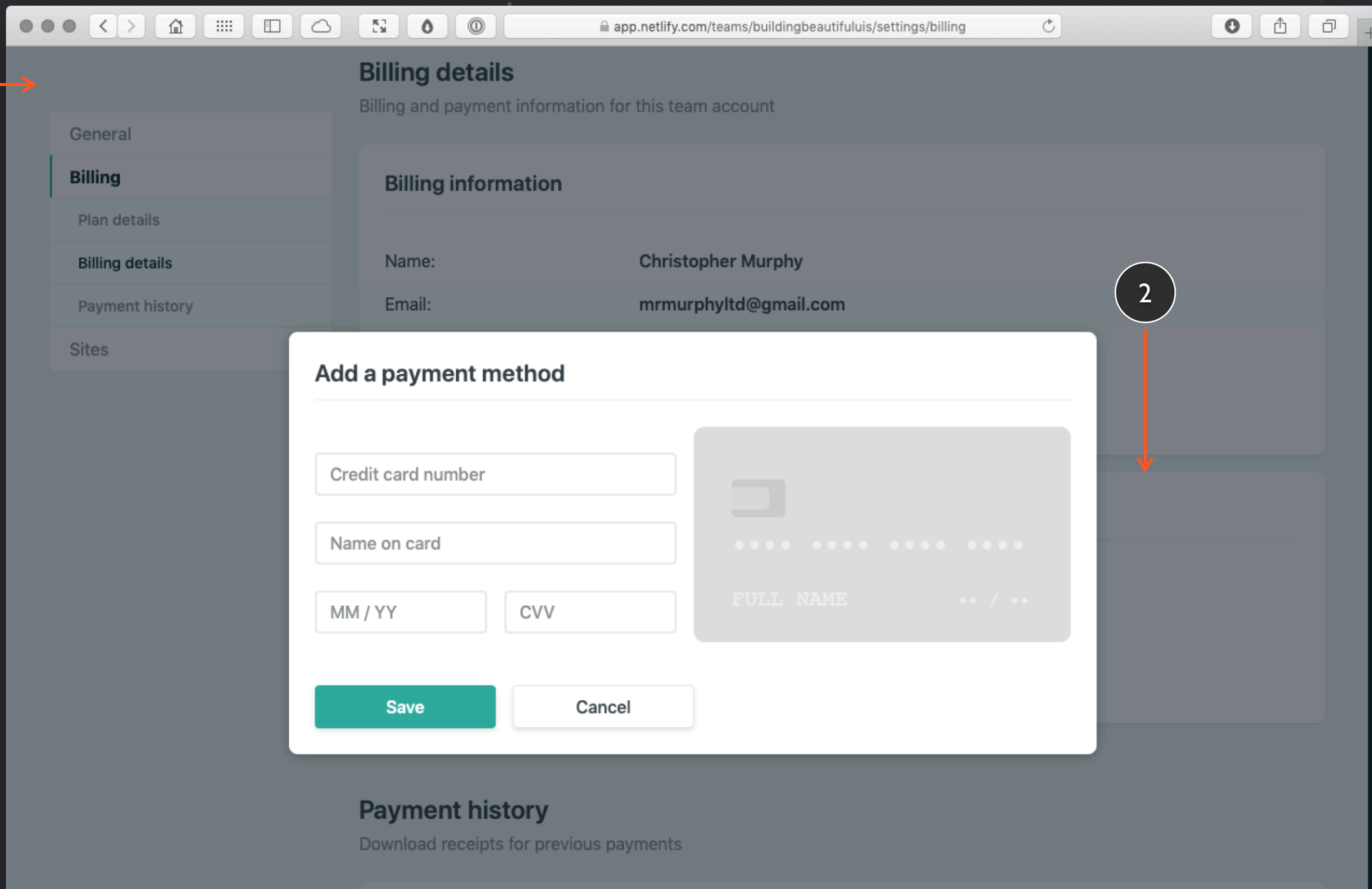

1. A grey overlay fades in. 2. The modal dialog animates in from top to bottom.

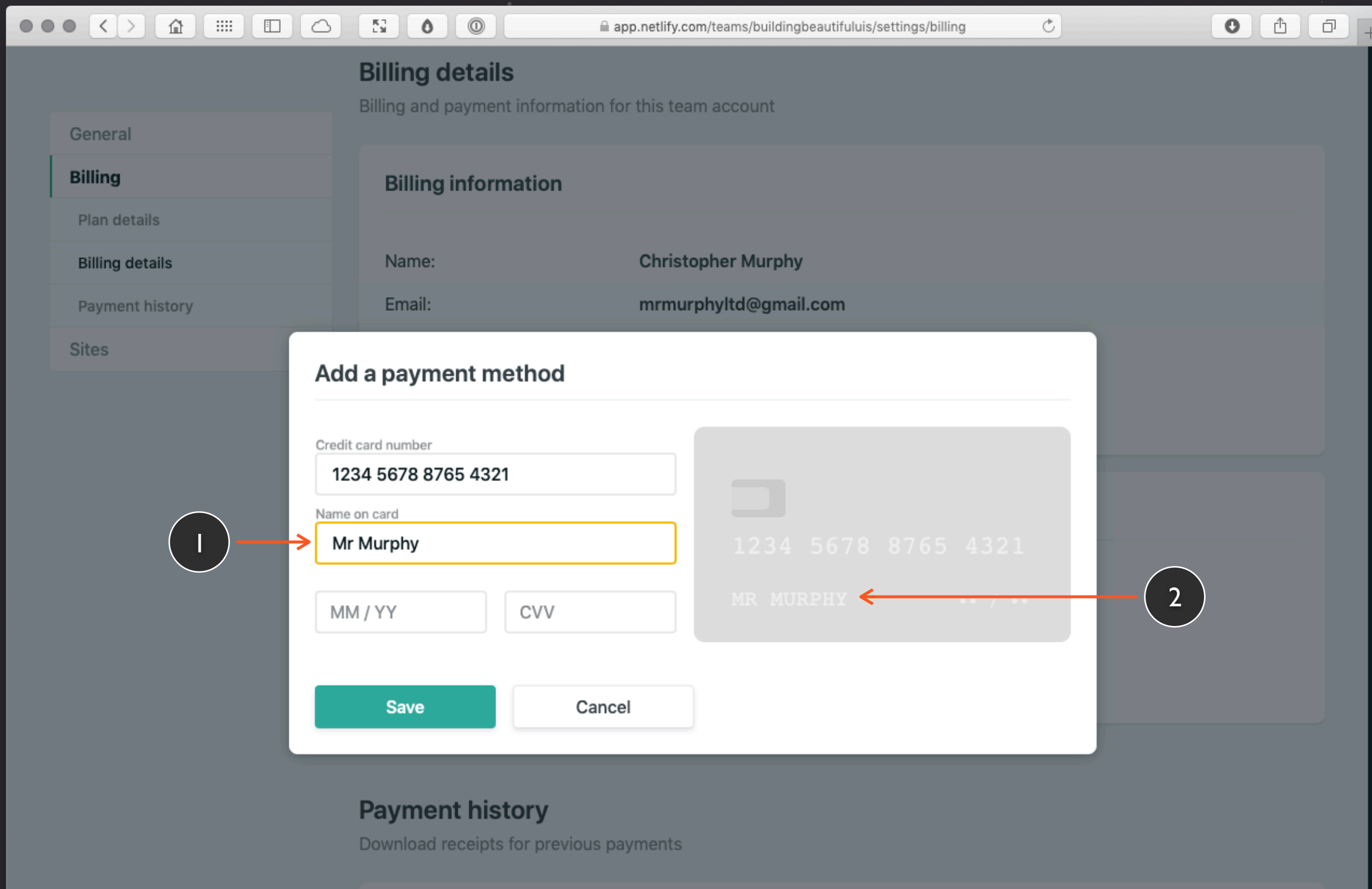

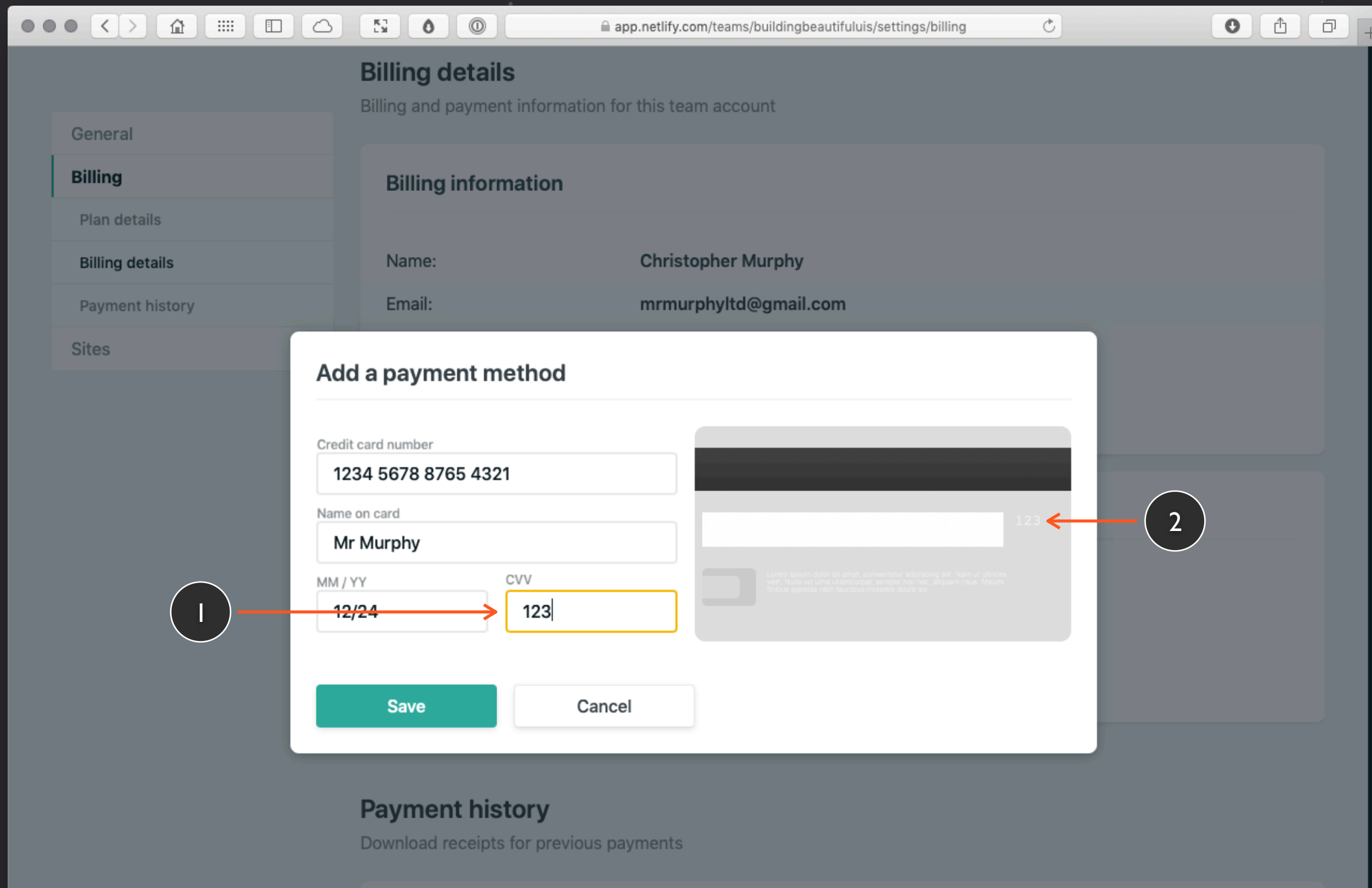

1. Enter you credit card details on the left; and 2. They appear on the 'credit card' on the right.



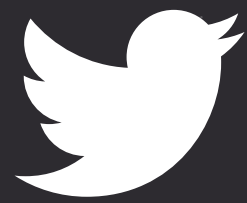
This pattern continues – enter on left (1), animate on right (2) – as you enter the rest of the details.
