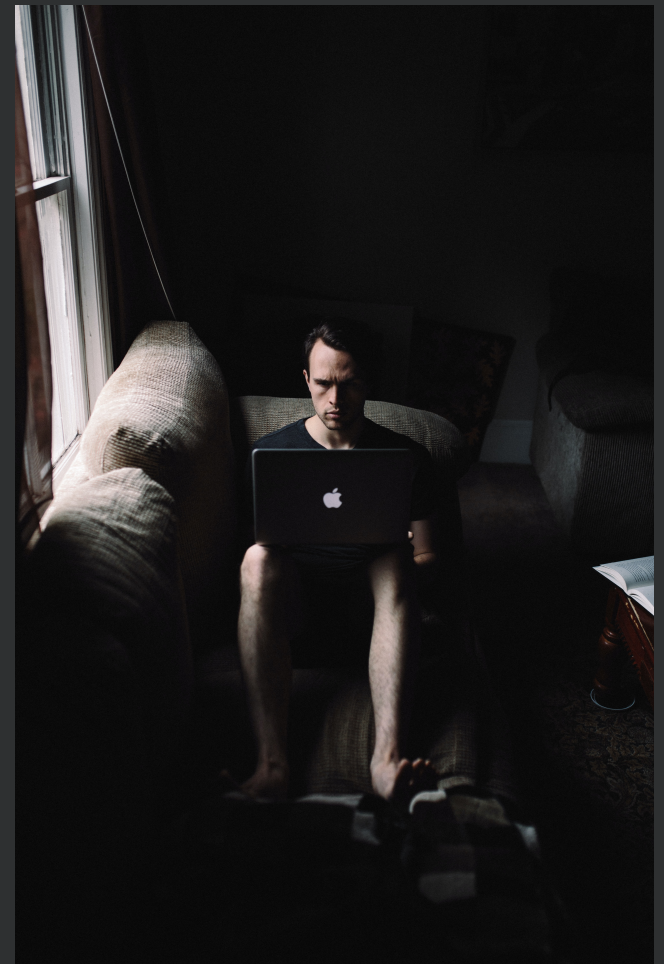


Defining Upstream

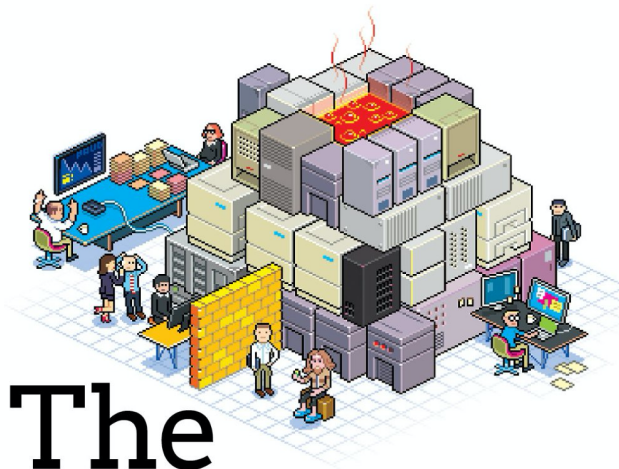

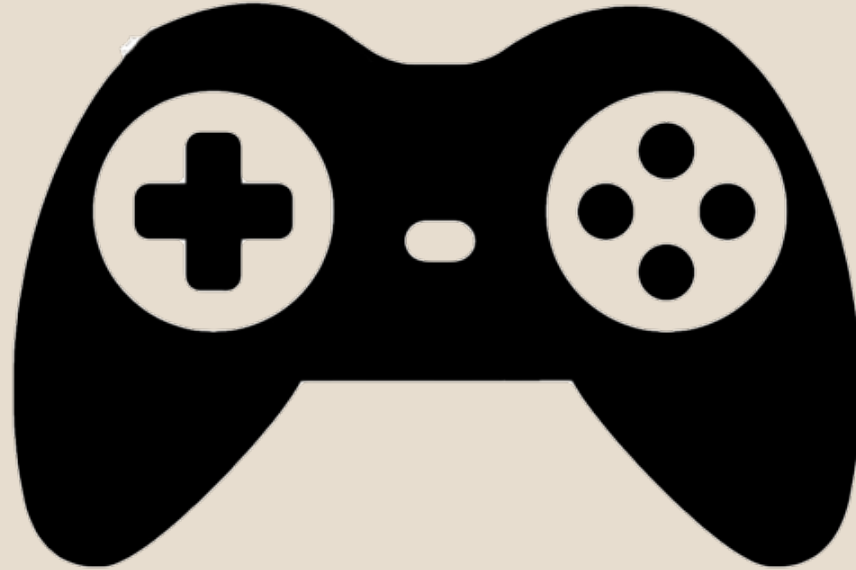

Now that you're semantically saturated...

How do you measure upstream work?

Things to keep in mind:

Understand your needs

Learn how to measure them

Establish baselines

Know your capacity

Track your rate of change

Set your goals

Iterate

Use (some of) the same metrics, new perspective and application

Upstream work is proactive,

Downstream work is reactive work.

Upstream work reduces stress and its extended impact.

To shift, categorize your downstream work and reduce it.

Know what you need to ask and why.

Define success, quantify with metrics.
