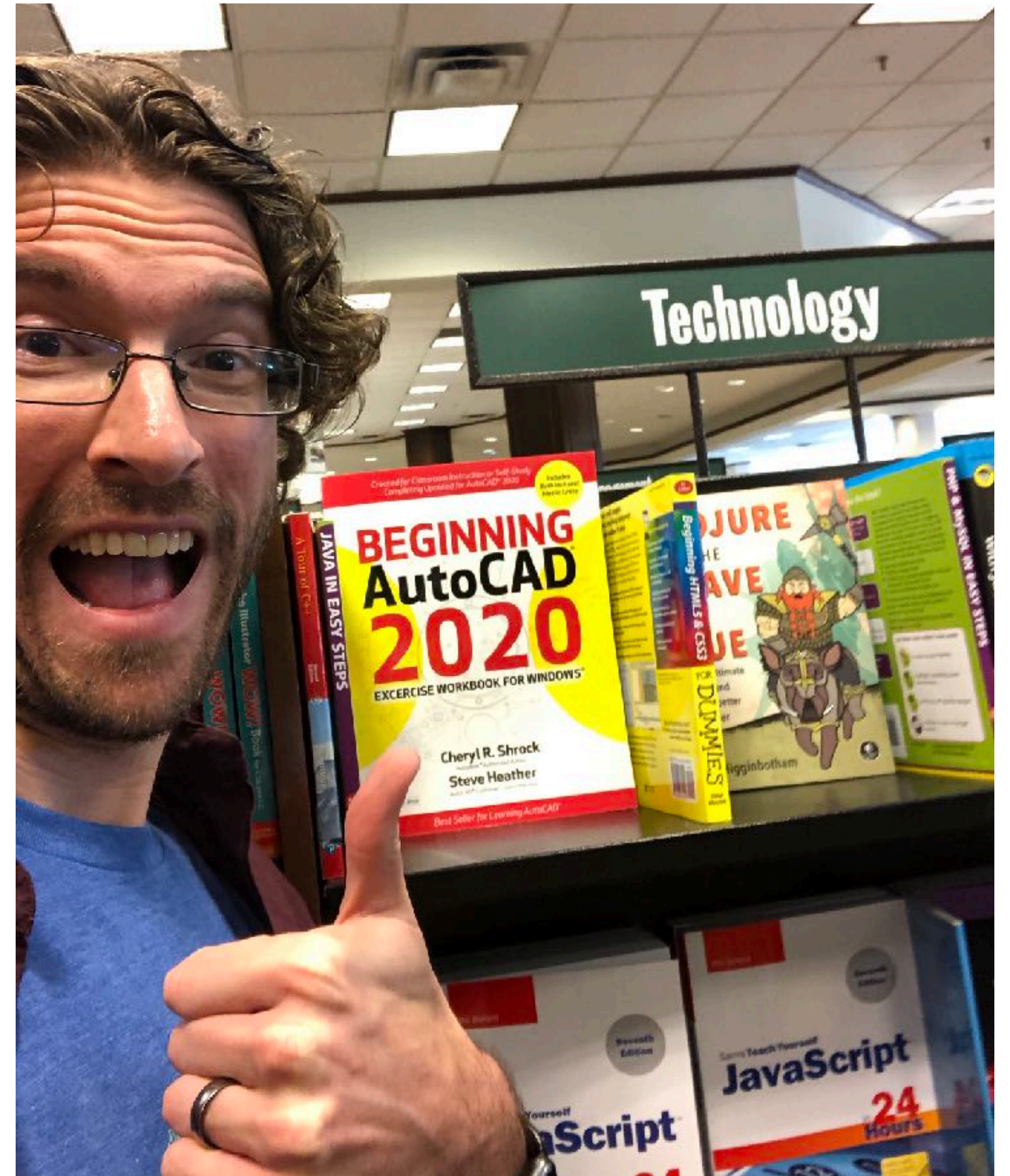

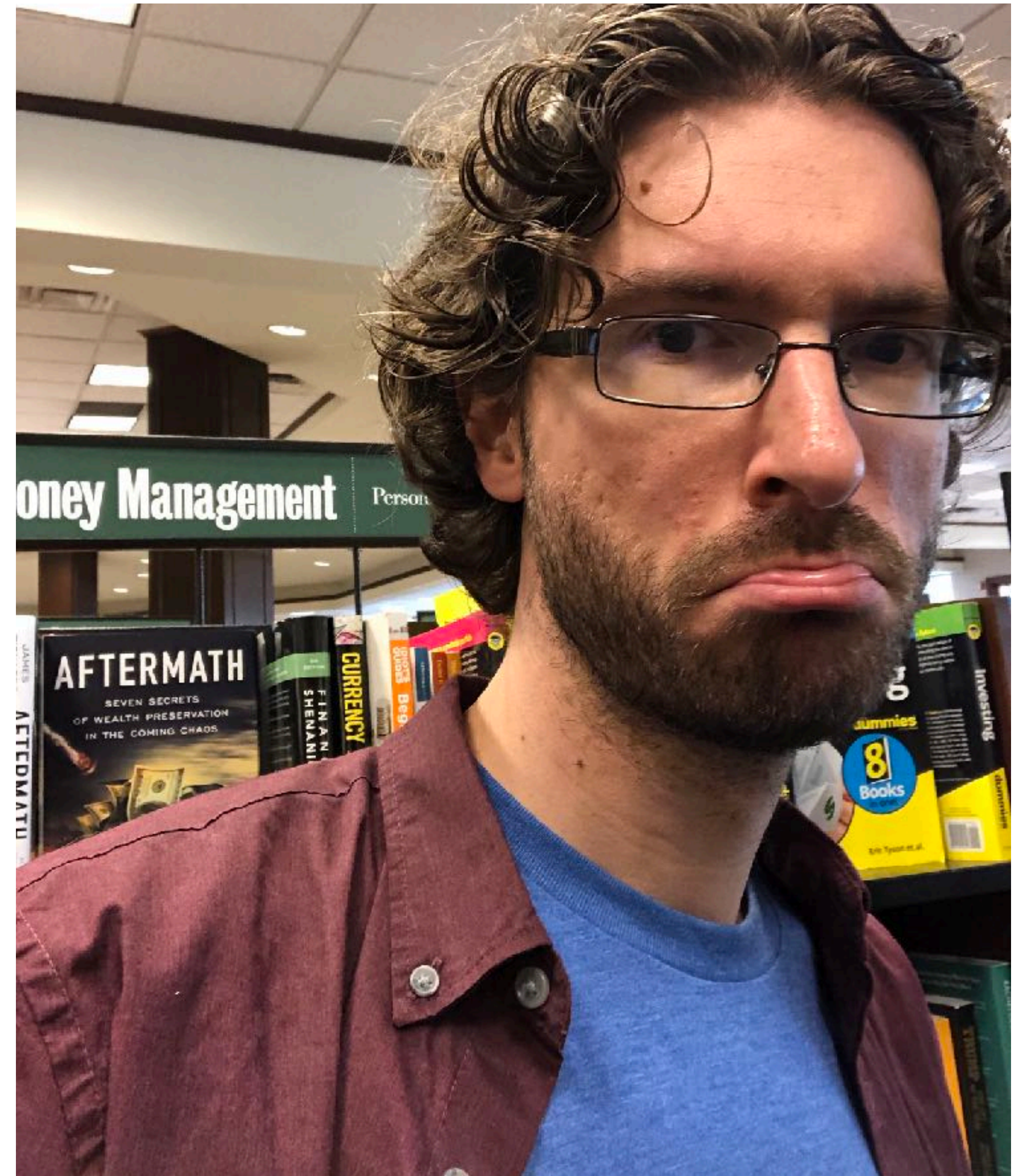


Where are the Web books? In Technology

The Russian Blues

- Goluboy (light blue) vs. Sinoy (dark blue)
- First study (2007 by Lera Boroditsky) to determine differences between shades
- Second study (2018 by Martin Maier and Rasha Rahman) to determine if these color words aided other perceptions
