Why connect RSS to Twitter?

- People following you on Twitter get updates about new post on your website.
- It saves time, because you post it once and it will be published on multiple sites.





The proces in pictures

- RSS feed
- Yahoo pipes
- FeedBurner
- Twitterfeed
- Ping.fm
- Twitter / FaceBook / LinkedIn / more







RSS feed



- Go to the website you want to use as input
- Find the RSS icon on the page or location-bar
- Copy the link (https://www.yireo.com/blog?format=feed&type=rss)
- The URL is needed in the next step.





Yahoo pipes



- Pipes is a powerful composition tool to aggregate, manipulate, and mash-up content from around the web.
- <u>Learn How to Build a Pipe in Just a Few Minutes</u>
 Pipes only sounds hard. Yahoo made a video tutorial.
 Watch it and see how you can quickly turn your idea into a usable, working feed. (http://video.yahoo.com/watch/5260536/13878389)
- The output of Yahoo pipes is a new RSS feed, to be used in the next step.





FeedBurner



- Use FeedBurner to get a SEO RSS link
- Use FeedBurner so others can signup for mail
- Use FeedBurner to get statistics
- Read the <u>Crash course #FeedBurner</u> written by Dae Punt (http://www.daepunt.com/en/crash-course-feedburner/)
- The output of FeedBurner is a new RSS feed, to be used in the next step.





TwitterFeed



- To automatically feed Ping.fm or Twitter
 I've chosen for Ping.fm, so I can automatically can feed
 LinkedIn, FaceBook and others as well
- Before using feeding to Ping.fm from Twitterfeed, we'll have to do some work in Ping.fm
- Twitterfeed will come back after two slides





Ping.fm



- Ping.fm can be used to feed multiple social networks at once. FaceBook, LinkedIn, Twitter and more
- Login to Ping.fm
- Add Twitter as a service, make sure "status updates" is enabled.
- Go to http://ping.fm/key and copy your application key.
 (To be used in the next step, Twitterfeed)





Bit.ly

bit.ly

- Use bit.ly to shorten URL
- Use bit.ly to get statistics
- Log in and add your Twitter details to "Linked Accounts"
- Use the "API login" and "API key" in Twitterfeed





Twitterfeed



- Login to Twitterfeed and create a new feed to Ping.fm
- Use the application key from Ping.fm
- Click 'get available methods' and set methode to 'status'
- Paste your feed from FeedBurner at 'RSS Feed URL'
- Go to "Advanced Settings" and set "Update Frequency", "Post Content". Shorten URL using bit.ly. Use the application login and key from Bit.ly





Final

- It can take a while before Twitterfeed add your newly created feed into their process. After that it will proceed on your given frequency.
- Don't post on the pages you get your input from. It will turn into a loop.
- We've used our own website as input in Yahoo Pipes. You can take any website you like, as long as it generates RSS feeds.
