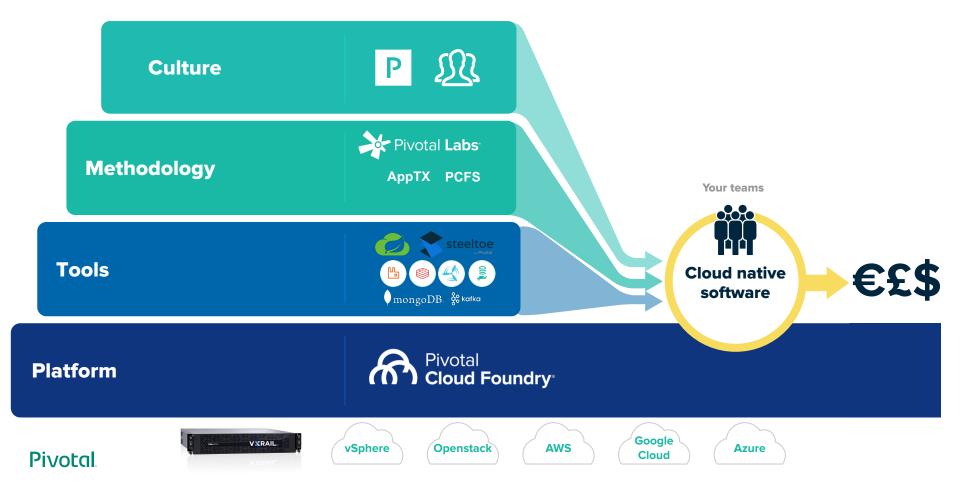

- Customer-centric software development permeating rest of company.

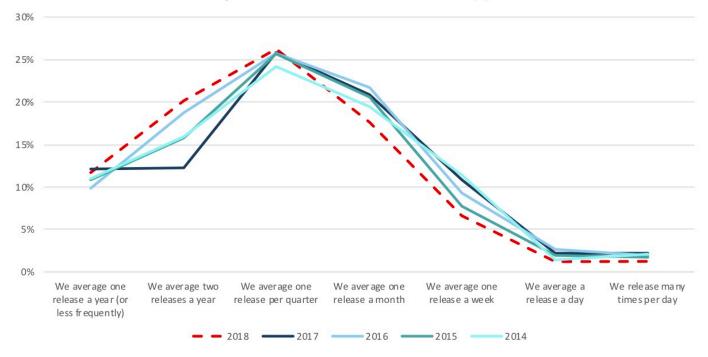

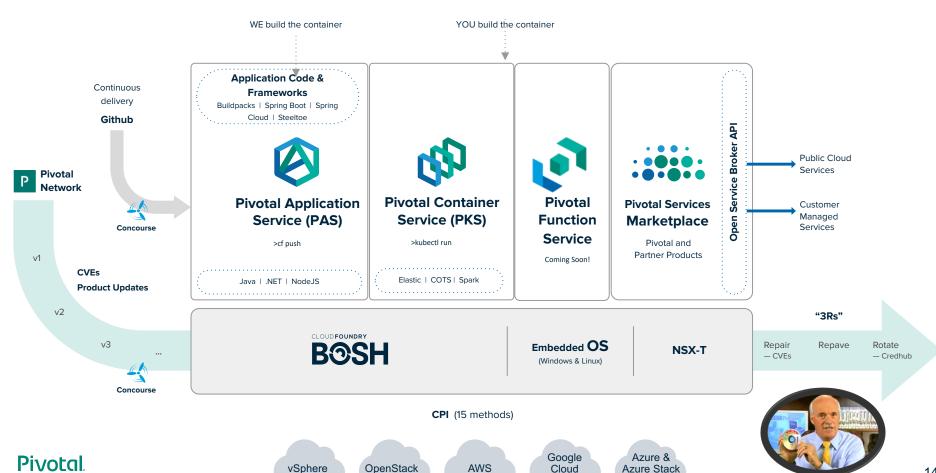

Small batch management

- Create a culture of innovation, risk taking, and focusing on people ("users")
- Give product teams autonomy, trust, and voice
- Establish trust by doing what you say, delegating, and celebrating failurelearning.
- Feedback loop: surveys (ENPS), silence, churn, results.
- Giving feedback: OKRs, praising process & stories, not just schedule

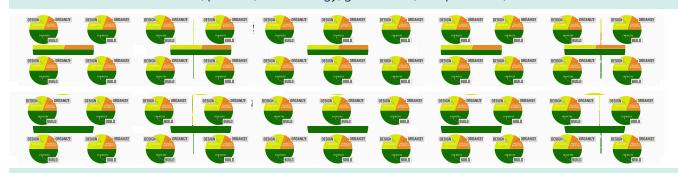

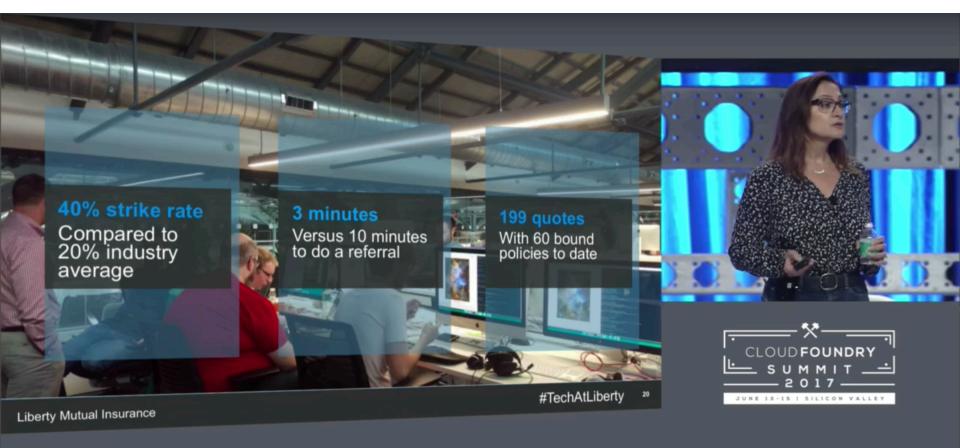

A new business in 6 months, doubling avg. sales rate



Comcast: 83% increase in release velocity from average 3-4 months to 15 days

Boeing: 80% reduction in 'time to value'

Verizon: 87% reduction in 'time to value'; 93% reduction in environment setup time

Allstate: Developers spending 80% of time coding vs. 20% (4X improvement)

Scotiabank: 3X product deploys per month

Liberty Mutual: Revenue-generating MVP in one month; 1K production deploys per day across 600 applications

Mercedes-Benz: 90% improvement in release velocity from ~30 days to 2-3 days

Verizon: 96% improvement in patching frequency, from patching every 6 months to weekly

T-Mobile: 83% reduction in product defect incident frequency; 67% reduction in time to resolve incidents

Boeing: 6X (600%) improvement in asset utilization

Scotiabank: In 10 months, scaled to 29 teams in 4 countries with 3X product deploys per month

T-Mobile: 43% improvement in application response time
